

DEFINITION FOR FEE STATUS






Barbadian nationals are defined as those children, who themselves possess either a Barbadian birth certificate or a Barbadian passport or who have at least one parent possessing such a birth certificate or passport.

Caribbean non-nationals are defined as those children, who themselves possess either a birth certificate or a passport from a country that is either a *full* member or an *associate* member of Caricom, or who have at least one parent possessing such a birth certificate or passport. This includes the following countries. Children from countries with Caricom *observer* status do not qualify for the tuition reduction.
